Maharani Student Union and RUSU Election 2017-18
Rules for Disqualification as per University Constitution 2017

No member of the Rajasthan University Student's Union/Constituent College Student's Union/other Unions shall be entitled to contest for any post of office-bearer or to become student member of the Assembly/Executive Council/Executive Committee as the case may be, if that student

- a) is not a full time regular student of any course of study in the University and not a member of the Rajasthan University Student Union.
- b) has exceeded the age limit as prescribed.
- c) has failed to clear all the papers, whether compulsory or elective, individually and in aggregate, including by absence (or not scored required credits in case of final examination) of the last Semester/Year in which he has taken admission in the preceding academic session of the year of contesting the election (whether Annual or Semester Scheme or whether the examination of University of Rajasthan or any other academic institution).
- d) has enrolled in two full time degree programme including other Universities.
- e) has been convicted of criminal offence including that of moral turpitude.
- f) has been duly declared as a "habitual offender"/ "history-sheeter" by the competent authority.
- g) has been punished by the University/College authorities for an act coercive in nature, especially to the women students, involving threat to life and dignity of others and involving threat to property of the University and for any other misconduct.
- h) has been found guilty and punished for use of unfair-means in any examination of College/University or any other examining body.
- i) has been found guilty of violation of Code of Conduct by the University.
